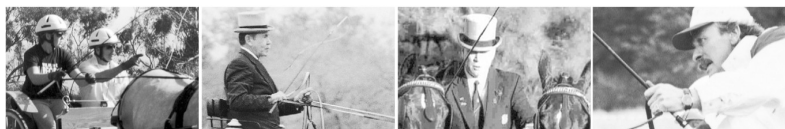

Division Descriptions

Horse Division – Single and multiple entries with equines over 14.2 hands

Pony/VSE Division - Single and multiple entries with equines 14.2 hands and under, including VSEs

Novice Division - Restricted to equines and/or drivers not having won three first place ribbons in an ADS-recognized and/or USEF-licenses Carriage Pleasure Driving competitions.

Directions to the Show

Belle Grey Farm is located at 21440 Belle Grey Lane, Upperville, VA 20184 and can be accessed coming from either Route 50 (John Mosby Hwy) or Route 7 (Harry Byrd Hwy). To use your GPS or online mapping software to locate our farm, you may need to use the former address of 33389 Piney Swamp Road, Upperville, VA 20184.

FROM ROUTE 50 – turn onto Willisville Road, turning left from eastbound Rte 50 and right from westbound Rte 50. Willisville continues 2-3 miles and will turn into Millville Road. When you reach the stop sign, turn right onto Green Garden Road. After ¼ mile, turn left onto Piney Swamp Road (unpaved). Our gate is ¼ mile up on the right

FROM ROUTE 7 – from Rte 7 east or west, take the exit for Round Hill which is Rte 7 Business. Exiting coming eastbound, you will turn left towards Round Hill and exiting coming westbound, you will turn right towards Round Hill. After about ½ mile, in Round Hill, you will pass an Exxon on the right and then turn left onto New Cut Road. Take New Cut about 10 miles – it will turn into Air-mont Road and then Green Garden Road. Turn right onto Piney Swamp Road (unpaved) and our gate is ¼ mile up on the right.

The Jameswood Pleasure Driving Classic is recognized by the American Driving Society and every class offered herein which is covered by the current rules and specifications of the Society will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

General Rules and Information

ADS Rules (version effective January 1, 2011) apply

1. Pre-entries must be postmarked by October 14, 2011. All entries must include ADS entry form, payment in full and copy of current negative Coggins test (dated within 12 months of the show date) and ADS waiver. **CHECKS SHOULD BE MADE OUT TO: BELLE GREY FARM.** For entry questions, please call 540-592-3462 or email admin@bellegreyfarm.com.

2. **Entry Fee:** \$15 per class **Post Entry:** \$25 per class based on available space. Post entries **MUST** be made by 8am on show day. Show Secretary will open at 7:00am day of show to accept post entries. **Refund Policy:** with written vet or physician note by entry close date. No refund on stabling fees.
3. **Time Schedule:** Saturday, October 22nd beginning at 8:30am. The Fault & Out course may be walked beginning at 7:30am and the Progressive Cones course may be walked during the lunch break.
4. **Participation:** All drivers are welcome. No driver and/or horse may compete in any obstacle course more than once. (Ch 17 Article 46, ADS Rules). **All participants – drivers, grooms, helpers and guests – will be required to sign the ADS disclaimer/waiver.**
5. **Stabling:** We have limited stabling on our property. Stalls will be rented on a first come-first served basis. Stall fees are \$50/night plus an additional \$10 stall deposit. **NO STALLIONS ALLOWED.** Please call or email for more details.
6. **Awards:** Six ribbons awarded in all classes. **Division Awards:** \$50 Driving Essentials gift certificate for all Division Champions; \$25 gift certificate for Reserve Champions. Entrants must compete in all classes of their division for Championship eligibility. Divisions must have at least 3 entries per class for Champion/Reserve Champion prizes to be awarded. Super Reinsmanship will decide ties.
7. **Points:** Weighted based on number of entries per class as follows:
6+ entries – 1st=7pts, 2nd=5pts, 3rd=4pts, 4th=3pts, 5th=2pts and 6th=1pt
5 entries – 1st=6pts, 2nd=4pts, 3rd=3pts, 4th=2pts and 5th=1pt
4 entries – 1st=5pts, 2nd=3pts, 3rd=2pts and 4th=1pt
3 entries – 1st= 4pts, 2nd= 2pts and 3rd=1pt
8. **Course:** Course maps will be available in your registration packets and Show Secretary's office which will open at 7:00am on the day of the show. Participants may walk the Fault & Out cones course beginning at 7:30am on show day or any time before the class begins. Progressive Cones course may be walked during the lunch break.

9. **ADS Rules:** The Jameswood Pleasure Driving Classic is run in accordance with the rules and regulations of the American Driving Society. It is, therefore, the competitor's responsibility to know the ADS rules and regulations of the Pleasure Driving Show. A copy of the rules is available on the ADS website (www.americandrivingsociety.org). ADS members must provide their ADS number with their entry. A \$30 non-member fee will be charged; it may be credited towards ADS membership.
10. **Vehicles:** Wire wheels and vehicles with pneumatic tires are allowed for VSEs only. Marathon vehicles are allowed in all. Management allows change of vehicle while still competing for championship under the same number. Any entry deemed unsafe by Show Management, Technical Delegate or Judge will not be permitted to compete.
11. **Horse Eligibility:** Horse must be at least 3 years old. Animals 14.2h and under will be shown as ponies with the exception of registered Arabians, Morgans, Saddlebreds and Quarter Horses which may show in the horse division at owner's discretion but may not cross enter. Junior and Novice drivers may not drive stallions. Animals 39" and under will be shown as VSEs.
12. **Schooling** areas will be clearly marked
13. **Responsibilities Toward the Horse:** Failure to comply with the following may incur elimination or disqualification.
 1. Whenever fully harnessed to a vehicle and while being harnessed to a vehicle, a horse must wear a bridle with reins attached and passed through the saddle terrets. Exception:
 - a. Once a horse is fully harnessed to a vehicle, one rein at a time may be adjusted.
 - b. Horse in multiple hitches must have at least one rein attached to the bridle while being harnessed to a vehicle.
 2. The horse must never be left unattended while put to a vehicle.
14. **Grooms/Passengers:** Four-in-hand and Unicorns are required to have 2 grooms or passengers on the vehicle. Pairs and Tandems, VSE Four-in-Hand and Unicorn are required to carry 1 groom or passenger. A groom/passenger is optional for single turnouts.
15. **Division/Class Size:** 3 entries constitute a class. Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any class. In addition, should the entries warrant, management reserves the right to split Divisions (i.e., Pony/VSE Division split into Open Pony and Open VSE). Divisions must have 3 competitors in each class for Champion/Reserve Champion prizes to be awarded.
16. **Dress/Harness:** Drivers and passengers should dress according to the style of their vehicle. No "period" costumes. Driving aprons or lap robes, hats, gloves and driving whip are required in all classes. Spares are recommended. Martingales and overchecks are prohibited except where permitted under ADS rules.
17. **Dogs are not permitted at this event.**
